RoHS II Statement European directive 2002/95/EG (RoHS) and 2011/65/EU (RoHS II)

Dear Sir or Madam,

the European directive 2002/95/EG (RoHS – Restriction of Hazardous Substance), which entered into force on 1st June 2006, was replaced by the new European directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II) on 21st July 2011. The main innovations of RoHS II are a gradual extension of the scope to virtually all electrical products and the omission of some exempt uses of restricted substances.

The following substances subject to the restriction of RoHS directive and may be included in the maximum stated maximum concentrations (weight percent) in homogeneous materials:

- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Exceptions exist for example for the use of lead as an alloying constituent of steel, aluminum and copper alloys.

In Germany the RoHS II directive is implemented by the Electric Substances Act since 09th May 2013. The topic of RoHS and the implementation of the relevant directives have been completed by us. The goods delivered by us do not contain restricted substances or group of substances according to the above-mentioned guidelines and are therefore compatible with RoHS II.

HSM Zamecki GmbH is anxious to provide only safe materials and products, to keep on guaranteeing a high environmental compatibility in future.
